

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03**

**A RESOLUTION REDUCING THE PAY RATE OF DAVID CLINE FROM \$23.00 TO \$17.00 PER HOUR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Mount Sterling, after careful thought and consideration, believes that it is appropriate to reduce the pay of certain Village employees due to fiscal uncertainty.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO**

**SECTION I:**

The Council for the Village of Mount Sterling reduces the hourly rate of David Cline from \$23.00 to \$17.00. This reduction in his hourly rate shall be effective immediately pursuant to the Fiscal Officer's decision.

**SECTION II.**

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

**SECTION III.**

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

**SECTION IV:**

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and to sound fiscal management and transparency of the finances of the Village Mount Sterling. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
