**A RESOLUTION ABOLISHING THE POSITION OF PUBLIC SERVICES  
SUPERVISOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the fiscal emergency the Village of Mount Sterling finds itself, requires immediate and drastic action to ameliorate the financial shortfall of the general fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF  
MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO**

**SECTION I:**

The Council for the Village of Mount Sterling abolishes the position of Public Services Supervision currently held by Brett Towler. The Administration is authorized to pay accumulated sick and vacation time pursuant Village policy. (240 hours of sick and accumulated vacation time)

**SECTION II.**

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

**SECTION III.**

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

**SECTION IV:**

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and to sound fiscal management and transparency of the finances of the Village Mount Sterling. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
