**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COURTNEY BRICKER, FISCAL OFFICER,
TO SUSPEND CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR
2018 BUDGET YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Mount Sterling understands the Village is in Fiscal Emergency. Council desires to ameliorate the Fiscal Emergency in a manner that engenders confidence in Council by the citizens of Mount Sterling and the State Auditor's Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF
MOUNT STERLING, STATE OF OHIO**

SECTION I:

The Council for the Village of Mount Sterling hereby suspends all contributions to the Capital Improvement Fund for the fiscal year of 2018.

SECTION II.

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

SECTION III.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.


SECTION IV:

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and to sound fiscal management and transparency of the finances of the Village Mount Sterling. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.


