ORDINANCE NO. 2018-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2018 BUDGET AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO DURING FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018 FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPLEMENTING A FIVE (5) YEAR FINANCIAL PLAN TO INSURE THE FINANCIAL SOLVENCY OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS: the Finance Committee with the support and guidance of the State Auditor's Office has prepared a five (5) year financial plan, and;

WHEREAS: the Council of the Village of Mount Sterling, after careful thought and consideration, has adopted the five (5) year plan in Resolution No. 2018-15, which is fully incorporated herein as if written.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION I:

Council of the Village of Mount Sterling amends Ordinance No. 2018-12 as follows to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Mount Sterling, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018 the following sums be, and they are hereby, set aside and appropriated pursuant to the five (5) year financial budget, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

SECTION II:

Sums expended from the preceding appropriations, which are proper charges against any other department, or against any firm, person, or corporation, if repaid within the period covered by such appropriations shall be considered re-appropriated for such original purposes; provided that the net total of expenditure under any appropriation shall not exceed the original total.

SECTION III.

The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw her warrants for payment for any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper approval of the officers or heads of departments authorized by law to make expenditures; provided that no warrant shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance.

SECTION IV:

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date permitted by law.

SECTION V.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

SECTION IV.

PASSED:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling. The emergency existing is the continued sound fiscal management of the Village's financial affairs. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
