

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-33**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2018 BUDGET AND MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING INCREASED ELECTRICAL UTILITY SERVICE DURING FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO:**

**SECTION I:**

Council of the Village of Mount Sterling amends Ordinance No. 2018-32 as follows to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the Village of Mount Sterling, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2018 to include increased electrical utility cost. See for line item 5101-531-311-0000.

**SECTION II:**

Sums expended from the preceding appropriations, which are proper charges against any other department, or against any firm, person, or corporation, if repaid within the period covered by such appropriations shall be considered re-appropriated for such original purposes; provided that the net total of expenditure under any appropriation shall not exceed the original total.

**SECTION III.**

The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw her warrants for payment for any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper approval of the officers or heads of departments authorized by law to make expenditures; provided that no warrant shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance.

**SECTION IV:**

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date permitted by law.

**SECTION V.**

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

**SECTION IV.**
