SECTION I:

The Council for the Village of Mount Sterling hereby accepts the donation of three hundred twenty-seven and 00/100 Dollars, \$327.00, from CKB Sterling One Stop for the purpose of supporting the James Cotton Football Camp.

SECTION II.

That the provisions of this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after the passage of this resolution and its approval by the Mayor and majority of Council.

SECTION III:

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law this resolution.

This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling and to sound fiscal management and transparency of the finances of the Village Mount Sterling. Additionally, the parents of the children who participate will have a chance to talk and communicate which will foster dialog.
