

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-22__

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-16 BY PROVIDING AN AMENDED CERTIFICATE TO THE MADISON COUNTY AUDITOR FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CORRECTLY STATING THE APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES IN THE UAN COMPUTER SYSTEM OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MOUNT STERLING, MADISON COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

The Council of the Village of Mount Sterling hereby approves the amendment to Ordinance No. 2015-16 for the purpose of amending the Certificate provided to the Madison County Auditor to correct the appropriations and expenditures previously entered into the UAN computer system as attached hereto:

COPY OF FUND TOTALS AND FUNDS ARE ATTACHED WITH TOTALS AND FUNDS THAT THE VILLAGE USED FOR FINAL APPROPRIATIONS.

SECTION II.

Sums expended from the preceding appropriations, which are proper charges against any other departments, or against any firm, person or corporation, if repaid within the period covered by such appropriations shall be considered re-appropriated for such original purposes, provided that the net total expenditure under any appropriation shall not exceed the original total.

SECTION III.

The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payment for any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper approval of the officers or heads of departments authorized by law to make expenditures; provided that no warrant shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the persons employed by the authority of and in accordance with law and Ordinance

The Fiscal Officer shall certify a copy of this Ordinance to the County Auditor to AMEND AND CORRECT.

SECTION IV.

That all other Ordinances and/or Resolutions in conflict herein are expressly repealed.

SECTION V.

That the Clerk of Council, pursuant to O.R.C §731.23, shall cause to be published in a manner required by law, this Ordinance.

SECTION VI.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling. The emergency existing is the payment of obligations existing and financial stability of the Village of Mount Sterling. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
