A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CHARLES NEFF, MAYOR, TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACT AS REQUIRED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Mount Sterling is planning to make capital improvements to Church Street and N. Market Street Improvements, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above and described is considered to be a propriety need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED by the Village of Mount Sterling:

Section 1: Charles Neff, Mayor, is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: Charles Neff, Mayor, is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Mount Sterling. The emergency existing is the continued sound fiscal management of the Village and to provide the citizens of Mount Sterling a safe environment to live and raise their children. This resolution shall be in full force and effective upon the passage and signing by the Mayor.
